Course Aims & Objectives

The aim of this course is to provide an opportunity for young swimmers to participate in tried and tested training methods and techniques necessary for competitive swimming. Our methods have produced over eighty Great Britain Senior International swimmers and medalists in the Olympic Games and European Championships.

All aspects of training are included, from special skills in individual strokes and land training consisting of cardiovascular circuits, weight training and isokinetics. Lectures include topics such as land training and race preparation. The physical and psychological demands are emphasized with a view to highlighting the stresses facing competitive swimmers, in particular, ensuring that training is productive and enjoyable for all, irrespective of age or ability.

Course Details

The course will be divided into number groups according to age, experience and training. Activities are generally carried out within these groups. Also, colour teams form the basis of many activities and fun competitions taking place during the course, culminating in a Swimming Gala on Saturday. Gym activities will include: running, circuits and an introduction to weight training.

Swimming Gala

This takes place on Saturday at 9am prompt, finishing around 10.30am. The events are continuous as we are aware that parents need to travel home. Swim events are all relay races with points awarded to colour teams with points from the weekly games added. Any monies left in the bank will be handed out in envelopes at the presentation. All swimmers will be presented with a photo and certificate. Afterwards, suit cases may then be collected from the main school entrance and children are free to leave.

Parents are welcome to attend the Gala and it would be appreciated if you could arrive at the pool by 8.45am.

From time to time photographs may be taken during activities for training and marketing purposes.

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Arrival & Departure

All course members are required to arrive at the main entrance of Kelly College on Sunday, the first day of the Swim School, for **registration at 3.30pm and no later than 4pm**. The school is situated on the (A386) Tavistock to Okehampton road, about half a mile from the centre of Tavistock. On arrival your child will be designated a House and dormitory accommodation. Each house is supervised by Swim School Staff and a matron, who is available to look after domestic requirements.

Equipment & what to wear

All children should be in possession of:

Sleeping bag or duvet and duvet cover	pillow and pillow case	toiletries
3 or 4 swimming costumes	2 or 3 towels	swimming goggles
Small bag to carry swim kit	drinks bottles	squash to dilute
Sports shorts and shirts	tracksuit	trainers

We will provide floats, pull buoys and fins.

All clothing and equipment must be clearly labelled

Lost property will be kept for 7 days.

Bank

It is recommended that all pocket money be deposited in the bank on arrival and just the amount required for daily use is withdrawn. The bank is safe and open at break times daily to withdraw or deposit money. It is recommended that £25 for the week is the maximum for the bank. Please enclose the money in an envelope ready for the bank. The bank will be responsible for any valuable possessions, but Swim School cannot accept any responsibility for loss or damage to possessions not left in their care. We would not recommend bringing mobile phones or MP3 players where possible.

Tuck Shop

A small amount of spending money is recommended as a tuck shop will be available daily. During the week there will also be a short trip into Tavistock Town Centre.
